SPEAKER: PREET BASSI, Chief Executive Officer, Center for Public Safety Excellence

Preet Bassi has been chief executive officer of the Center for Public Safety Excellence (CPSE) since 2014 and oversees work across all fire department accreditation, credentialing, and education programs with a focus on the organization's strategic direction. During her tenure, CPSE has experienced unprecedented growth and impact. Prior to CPSE, she was the director of finance and administration for the International Accreditation Service and managed the Fire and Life Safety and Building Department Accreditation Programs. Bassi chairs the NFPA 1022 Technical Committee, a new standard for fire service analysts.
